

Boom Lifts

Boom Lifts Training Ontario - Boom lifts are machinery that has a platform which can be lowered or lifted to many heights, hence making this piece of equipment an important requirement in a wide variety of professions. Offered in many different specialized kinds such as aerial lifts, scissor lift trucks, and knuckle boom lifts, each type functions very specifically.

Aerial platform lifts are most regularly used to carry people at skiing lodges who are not comfortable with a ski lift. These lifts maneuver much like an elevator, skiers may be slowly but surely moved up the mountain, stopping at stations along the path until they reach the top. Aerial platform lifts are also used in construction, moving people safely up and down the sides of multi-level building sites.

Scissor lifts are also in the boom jack category. They are used regularly by service providers as an idyllic system to permit workers to complete upkeep and repair on wires and cables that are attached to poles. Phone, cable television and power companies have relied on the efficiency of this type of boom lift for years.

Knuckle boom forklifts are built to be used in rough terrain locales where the need to be able to reverse direction is necessary. This style of boom is able to fit into many tight places that a scissor lift cannot. Working amid multiple equipment in a production facility or in close proximity sandwiched between two walls, the knuckle boom also features a standard table equipped with rails for protection and worker safety.

Based on the work requirements and the nature of work to be completed will establish the appropriate type of boom lift to choose. Fortunately, there is a model suitable for almost any application.
