Introduction

General Hazards

Common types of hazard in a warehouse setting are slips, trips and falls. These accidents are usually caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over an item which has not been put away properly. Removing or placing things from storage can lead to a slip or fumble, potentially leading to both thing and worker to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when staff are moving things on various types of floor surfaces and on various levels. One more common hazard is getting hit by falling stuff. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack things on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting methods are another common danger.

Warehouse machinery carries inherent hazards. Accidents or injuries can be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated correctly. Warehouse tools, like for instance pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, should be used carefully throughout packing, unpacking and loading.

Materials which are hazardous, combustible or flammable present one more type of workplace danger while being stored inside a warehouse. Workers should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers when working around dangerous materials.
