Ontario Telehandler Certification - A telehandler certification course could be taken by prospective operators who have previous experience with driving typical forklifts and for people with no past experiences on a lift truck. The real-world training provided by these courses produces graduates who know the proper and safe utilization of these types of machinery.

Telehandler certification courses could be finished at a third party location or at the trainees work site. To obtain the formal training at a certain training facility, the manufacturer may work out a licensing agreement in order to bring other individuals to a training facility. This alternative offers those training with the chance to learn to utilize the equipment in a controlled environment. Upon completion, participants receive a certification or license to operate this kind of equipment.

When the training is performed on the worksite, a qualified instructor is sent to the work location. This is the best way to make certain that your staff receive particular training on the equipment which they will be utilizing, helping to train the trainee in their own work setting. Trainees learn about possible dangerous situations which could arise on the actual work place. The instruction focuses on whatever circumstances that are specific to the work location, allowing operators to be ready to safely deal with these elements.

"Telehandler" is an abbreviated version of the term "telescopic handler," which references the equipment's extending or telescoping arm supporting a fork. The controls and characteristics of the telehandler are rather similar to a forklift. A telehandler has the capability of transporting and lifting loads up and away from the vehicle. Wrong use of telehandlers could result in serious accidents. If load restrictions are exceeded, the equipment can tip because of excess weight on the lift. It is an operator's responsibility to know load limits and to safely make use of these equipment.

"Conversion" classes are designed for operators who have been certified to use a forklift. These conversion classes will teach the differences between the operation of a telehandler and a forklift, all the while trying to avoid repetitive information which the forklift operator is already familiar with. For trainees who have no prior experience using telehandler machinery, training includes the basic utilization and operation of the machinery. Some groups also provide refresher programs.
