Forklift Training Guidelines

The following checklist is vital for whichever workplace which has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions should be answered with "yes" if all the safety rules and regulations are being followed. A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural weakness that might cause accident, injury or damage to machine.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways well marked and provided?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to workers?
- 7) The lift truck tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) The seat of the forklift is in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Are annual inspections of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Is there a readable load chart on the forklift?
- 14) Can the operators read and understand the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different uses and attachments?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the forklift working correctly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) The forklift overhead cage is fitted right?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to use the machinery?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of forklifts being operated?
- 22) Do operators know their duties to report any equipment damage and forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed every day?
