Ontario Aerial Lift Training - An aerial work platform is a mechanical access platform. This particular machinery provides access to otherwise inaccessible places for equipment or people. Also referred to as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the device is often utilized to access high places. Construction and maintenance employees usually must use aerial work platforms on the job. They are utilized by firefighters for emergency access.

Meant for temporary application, aerial work platforms are different from elevators, which provide permanent access to high areas. An aerial work platform is meant to be operated by one individual, and could lift weights of less than one ton. Some types have higher load limits. There are various types of aerial work platforms; for example, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

A lot of the aerial work platforms are equipped together with compressed air connectors for power tools and electrical outlets. For specialist jobs, such as lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform may come with special tools.

Anyone required to operate an aerial lifting device needs training, along with their superiors. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial device work places likewise must go through training. Trainees would learn aerial lifting device operation. They will likewise gain an understanding of the regulations which apply to the safe use of these machines. Rules differ within different provinces, and in federally regulated worksites.

Workers who work near or are required to be lifted by an aerial lifting machinery needs to be aware of all the possible dangers. An Aerial Lift Training Video could be shown in a general safety session in order to educate all of the staff who are lifted by them or work near them.

Aerial Lift Training Program comprises modules focused on the following: Hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The particular program is designed to train employees on the safe use of self-propelled, elevated work platforms and self-propelled, boom supported, elevated work platforms. A certificate will be provided to workers who complete the program, signed by a qualified individual to confirm successfully finishing a hands-on practical exam.
